ELMWOOD HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE:

Elmwood High School is a public high school serving 105 students in a rural setting about 40 miles from Hudson, WI, and 35 miles from Eau Claire, WI. The high school staff includes 16 teachers and various support personnel. The average composite ACT score is 20.8. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The EHS school year consists of four terms, each nine weeks long. Credits and grades are awarded at the end of each term, but cumulative GPA is only awarded every two terms (each semester). EHS has an eight period day, with one mandatory study hall. Students have seven academic classes a day, lasting 48 minutes each. EHS has the following graduation requirements:

- 26 credits to graduate
- Minimum credits in required subject areas:
 - ◆ English – 4 credits
 - ◆ Social Studies – 3 credits
 - ◆ Math – 3 credits
 - ◆ Science - 3 credits
 - ◆ Physical Education – 1.5 credits
 - ◆ Health - .5 credit

- 4 year College – 55%
- 2 year College – 29%
- Workforce – 10%
- Military – 6%

AP/HONORS COURSE OFFERINGS

EHS does not offer Honors courses. AP courses are only available through virtual school. Students do have the option, to take college courses through Youth Options. We also offer Transcribed Credit for several courses through Chippewa Valley Technical College.
